CLUB SPONSORED CCW CLASS at the VSA clubhouse!! May 2 & 3, 2022. (June 6/7, July 4/5, etc.)

As part of your VSA membership, the once-a-month CCW classes **at the clubhouse** are FREE! You do not have to call first, just have proof of your VSA membership in good standing (yellow receipt or membership card). Membership applications, renewals, or membership payments will not be accepted at the class.

Wade Roberts will normally hold the CCW class at the clubhouse <u>the first Monday AND Tuesday of each month</u>, 5PM to 9PM. Non-members incur a fee of \$80 for an initial permit class (8 hours) and \$40 for a renewal class (4 hours). Renewal classes can be attended on either Monday or Tuesday, and initial CCW application classes can be attended across months – Monday one month, and Tuesday the next month, for example.

Everyone attending the class will also have to qualify with their permit pistols by shooting at the range. Non-members will incur a range use fee of \$20, while members have range privileges already. You must qualify with each pistol on your permit. If you cannot qualify on the designated day, non-members pay a \$20 range fee and a \$20 qualification fee, while VSA members pay a \$10 qualification fee.

The CCW Instruction and Qualification certificates are good for six months for initial application or renewal, so you can plan ahead and have plenty of time. Don't wait, get your CCW or renew it!

HUNTER SAFETY EDUCATION: At the April 14, 2022, club meeting, Loren Metzler, HSE instructor, stated that Hunter Safety Education instructors have the approval to start "in-person" classes. No dates have been set at this time for classes at the VSA club house. Classes are available online as well at this time. Hunter-ed.com is a delegated provider for the California Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Ladies' night will be once a month on the 4th Wednesday of each month (May 25, June 22, July 27, etc) from 5:00pm to 8:00 pm. RSOs will be on duty from 5 pm to 8 pm (or until dusk) for women and girls to shoot and share hints and tips with each other. Some things to remember: there is NO charge to shoot and you do NOT need to be a member, so please tell your female friends, family and co-workers. Bring your own guns and ammo along with eye and ear protection (some loaner eye and ear protection may be available). You can bring your own targets, or buy some at the range.

On a recent trip to Tennessee, I learned the state has an aggressive program to "Help stop the spread of forest pests in Tennessee." How you can help stop the spread of forest pests in Tennessee: *Leave firewood at home – don't transport it to campgrounds or parks. *Use firewood from local sources near where you are going to burn it, or purchase state or federally certified wood. *If you have moved firewood, burn all of it before leaving your campsite. *Tell your friends not to move firewood. Remind them than in quarantined Tennessee counties, it is illegal to move firewood.

From Vermont to North Dakota to Hawaii to Texas, pests hitchhiking on firewood can spread and destroy millions of trees. Information for every state can be found at: https://www.dontmovefirewood.org/

California prohibits bringing firewood into the state if it originated in an area infested with a harmful tree pest such as emerald ash borer, spotted lanternfly, Asian longhorned beetle, and/or spongy moth. For example, moving firewood into California from most midwestern and eastern states is against the law in order to prevent the spread of emerald ash borer. Bringing firewood into California can introduce these and other invasive pests which cause immense damage to natural and agricultural resources.

Many midwestern and eastern states prohibit the movement of firewood from California into their states since this can spread forest pests like thousand cankers disease of walnut.

Because California has existing regional infestations of regulated pests like the red imported fire ant, sudden oak death, and light brown apple moth, it is against the law to move firewood out of, or within, most western counties of the state. Many parts of southern California have additional forest pests that can be accidentally moved on firewood, including goldspotted oak borer and invasive shot hole borers.

California's National Parks, State Parks, and some County Parks prohibit cutting or collecting firewood within parks and instead encourage visitors to buy local or heat-treated firewood.

"Local" firewood refers to firewood sourced within 50 miles of where it is burned, Continued from page 3. but within 10 miles is ideal. Due to the risks and regulations involved with moving firewood, the State Department of Agriculture and the US Forest Service Region 5 ask that you "buy it where you burn it".


