**CLUB SPONSORED CCW CLASS at the VSA clubhouse!!** The CCW class is scheduled for Monday and Tuesday, **JUNE 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>**, 5pm to 9pm. Next month's class is scheduled for June 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup>.

As part of your VSA membership, the once-a-month CCW classes **at the clubhouse** are FREE! You do not have to call first, just have proof of your VSA membership in good standing (yellow receipt or membership card). Membership applications, renewals, or membership payments will not be accepted at the class.

Wade Roberts will normally hold the CCW class at the clubhouse the first Monday AND Tuesday of each month, 5PM to 9PM. Non-members incur a fee of \$80 for an initial permit class (8 hours) and \$40 for a renewal class (4 hours). Renewal classes can be attended on either Monday or Tuesday, and initial CCW application classes can be attended across months – Monday one month, and Tuesday the next month, for example.

Everyone attending the class will also have to qualify with their permit pistols by shooting at the range. Non-members will incur a range use fee of \$20, while members have range privileges already. You must qualify with each pistol on your permit. If you cannot qualify on the designated day, non-members pay a \$20 range fee and a \$20 qualification fee, while VSA members pay a \$10 qualification fee.

The CCW Instruction and Qualification certificates are good for six months for initial application or renewal, so you can plan ahead and have plenty of time. Don't wait, get your CCW or renew it! One of WTTA's main goals is to educate and inform. It's okay to talk about mental health, and that conversation can and should happen around firearm ownership. Here you can find informational sheets that explain why it's important to take care of your mental health along with links to WTTA's screening resources.

Our Mission: Through formal education, outreach, and engagement with the mental health and firearms communities, Walk the Talk America aspires to reduce firearm suicides and other negative incidents associated with firearms ownership.

Our Vision for the Future: Eradicating the prejudice that both the firearms and mental health industries face while reducing the number of tragedies and deaths that have occurred over the years since the US has had a decline in mental health funding and education. Creating an organization that is solely focused on making change and is made up of experts from different fields and all walks of life that is not corrupted by politics, the media, or personal prejudices.

Mr. Willetts pointed out that WTTA through their website provides free, anonymous, mental health screenings and additional resources for professional help. Use the screenings to get a quick snapshot of your mental health. These screenings are not a diagnosis, but a starting point of helpful information you can choose to share with your health care provider for a full assessment.

They offer a series of fliers for gun manufacturers and firearm retailers as well as information on communicating to customers the importance of mental health to firearm owners.

At the June board meeting directors and officers learned more about the junior rifle and 4H Shooting program relationship and how the relationship might look like in the future. Frank T. attended the recent 4H Shooting program leader training. He related that years (decades, actually) ago, 4H had a special arrangement to have the St. Aloysius 4H shooting program as a "spin-off" of 4H. Moving forward this year, Frank said, 4H directors want to have the St. A program back under the 4H umbrella. Esther G. provided that the 4H "year" is August 1 to July 31.

It is possible the 4H shooting program leader might not be the VSA shooting program leader. For the program and partnership to continue with the VSA club, after further discussion it was decided to have the person(s) who becomes the 4H/VSA shooting leader to: 1) be a VSA club member, 2) attend VSA board meetings, 3) have the program firearms DROS'd in their names (to be the owners of), 4) attend VSA range safety officer training.

The good news is that after attending the two-day 4H leader training class, at least one person has expressed interest in becoming a 4H and VSA shooting program leader.
