ELECTION of Officers and Directors: The election is scheduled for the December 14, 2023, general club meeting. There are five (5) director positions that will be open at that time. The VSA club has 10 directors (also known as board members). Directors serve for 2-year terms, with half of the positions to be filled this election and half to be filled at next year's election.

There will be two (2) elected director positions to be voted on. The following directors are nearing the end of their elected term: Royce Nalls and Sean Vedenoff.

There will be three (3) appointed director positions open at that time. The two year terms of Chris Calhoun and Kevin Vedenoff are coming to a close. The (appointed) one-year term of Terry Henry is also coming to a close. (Terry Henry was appointed to the board in December 2022 to fill a vacancy that opened in July 2022.) The club president has the responsibility of making the appointments for those positions.

Officers serve one year terms. The candidates for the positions of President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary are voted on each year.

The VSA Election Committee is chaired by Esther Gipson. To place your name on the ballot or for more information about the election or the positions that are available please contact Esther at 559-732-7638.

Nominations for officers and directors are now being accepted! Please contact Esther by Tuesday, October 10th, for your intention to run for one of the positions that will be open.

On or before October 31, 2023, the election (Nomination) committee will present a list of eligible nominees to the club secretary, Chris Norman. A notice of the election and the list of nominees will be included in the December newsletter prior to the election. Nominations for directors may also be received from the floor during any meeting of the voting members at which directors are to be elected. (In other words, write-ins are accepted at the December 14th meeting.) More information on page 2.

Election info:

Pertinent information regarding the election (voting rights, qualifications, nomination of directors) is spelled out in the club bylaws (dated 7-21-2014) and is presented as follows:

- 3.3. Voting Rights. All regular members in good standing shall be entitled to cast one vote with respect to those matters submitted to the members for action or approval (this shall include both adult members of a family membership, Life Members and Social Members). There shall not be any voting of members by proxy. Associate, Honorary and Junior Members shall have no voting rights. Votes may be taken by voice, by a show of hands or by written ballot. Voting members shall have no right to cumulate their votes.
- 5.3. Qualifications for Office. Every director must be a member in good standing of this Corporation for two years prior to his/her election. Each director must be a U.S. citizen. No person who is holding public office is eligible to be a director. Each director shall serve without compensation except for reasonable expenses incurred for the Corporation. Directors appointed by the holder of any office or an officer or board of any other organization are to act in their own right and not as a representative of any interest or group. Each director shall be at least 18 years of age.
- 5.7. Nomination of Directors. At least forty-five (45) days prior to the annual meeting of the voting members, the Nominations Committee shall present a list to the Secretary containing the names of eligible nominees as directors for the ensuing year. Said list shall contain the names of at least one eligible nominee to each vacancy. A notification of the annual meeting of the voting members and a list of nominees to the voting members shall be included in the Corporation newsletter prior to the election. Nominations for directors may also be received from the floor during any meeting of the voting members at which directors are to be elected.

From the September club and board meetings:

As deer season approached in September, for certain zones in California and out of state, the range saw a big increase in activity. When you arrive at the range it is required that all shooters sign in to the log book. Saturday, September 9th saw four pages of log book entries – nearly 80 shooters!

We are pleased to announce the addition of five (5) new RSOs to the roster. They are currently undergoing on-the-job training. Russ Beechinor will be scheduling an RSO safety training class in the near future. Russ said we really need to bolster the number of volunteer RSOs. Being a Range Safety Officer is rewarding and <u>fun!</u> Flexible days - you choose the "public shoot" days at the range to work with the other RSOs. We ask for a minimum commitment of four days a year. Don't live in Visalia? Don't let that deter you. You can do it! Women? Yes, you can be a vital influence in the growing number of women shooters at the range. Who better to reduce the anxiety of a woman with little shooting experience? CLUB SPONSORED CCW CLASS at the VSA clubhouse!!

The CCW class is scheduled for Monday, **October 2**, and Tuesday, **October 3rd**, 5pm to 9pm. Next month's class is scheduled for November 6 & 7 - the first Monday and Tuesday of the month.

As part of your VSA membership, the once-a-month CCW classes **at the clubhouse** are FREE! You do not have to call first, just have proof of your VSA membership in good standing (yellow receipt or membership card). Membership applications, renewals, or membership payments will not be accepted at the class.

Instructors Wade Roberts and Albert Chan will normally hold the CCW class at the clubhouse the first Monday AND Tuesday of each month, 5PM to 9PM. Non-members incur a fee of \$80 for an initial permit class (8 hours) and \$40 for a renewal class (4 hours). Renewal classes can be attended on either Monday or Tuesday, and initial CCW application classes can be attended across months – Monday one month, and Tuesday the next month, for example.

Everyone attending the class will also have to qualify with their permit pistols by shooting at the range. Non-members will incur a range use fee of \$20, while members have range privileges already. You must qualify with each pistol on your permit. If you cannot qualify on the designated day, non-members pay a \$20 range fee and a \$20 qualification fee, while VSA members pay a \$10 qualification fee.

The CCW Instruction and Qualification certificates are good for six months for initial application or renewal, so you can plan ahead and have plenty of time. Don't wait, get your CCW or renew it!
