The **JANUARY 2024** CCW class is scheduled for Saturday, January 6th, 8 am to 5 pm – held on the first Saturday of the month. The morning portion of the class is at the VSA clubhouse, the afternoon portion of the class is at the VSA range. Everyone attending the class will also have to qualify with their permit pistols by shooting at the range. The class is free to current VSA club members. Non-members will pay \$60 for a renewal (one session) CCW class; \$100 for a new (two class sessions) CCW permit application. You do not have to call first, just have proof of your VSA membership in good standing (yellow receipt or membership card). Membership applications, renewals, or membership payments will not be accepted at the class.

This is the information I received by text from Albert Chan, CCW instructor, on 12-28-23:

"Good morning, Chris, so I called the DOJ and they said that the emergency order was a proposal and it has not been finalized yet, (and) that all instructors should be receiving an update this week. As far as SB2, that also is in question because the Supreme Court shot some of it down but recently California filed an appeal with the 9th District (court) so everything is like on a stand still until we get updated information. I've been in contact with (the) Sheriff's office and they are more in the dark then we are. They didn't get the emergency order and barely found out about it last week. The hope is to hold class on January 6th for renewals.

"This is the text I got from Wade with Russ's input. But everything is subject to change:

"Because of changes to CCW mandated by SB2 the CCW class will be moved to the first Saturday of each month and will be 8 to 5. The morning, 8-12, will be classroom at the clubhouse. After lunch, it will be at the range. Renewal will be 8 hours and new applicants will be 16 hours so they will need two sessions."
