At the **January 11th meeting:** We heard that the CCW classes throughout Tulare County (at a minimum) have been put on hold. In a letter from the Sheriff's office to all the Tulare County CCW instructors, it was stated, "the Tulare County Sheriff's office encourages you all to temporarily suspend CCW training courses until clear direction and certification processes are provided by the state."

As of January 31st, 2024, I have not received any updates to say the CCW procedures will be moving forward. All CCW instructors must reapply to the state to reestablish themselves as qualified DOJ CCW instructors. A qualified instructor must obtain a training certificate from one either 1) Bureau of Security and Investigative Services, Department of Consumer Affairs, State of California – Firearm Training Instructor; 2) Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST), State of California – Firearms Instructor or Rangemaster; or, 3) Authorization from a State of California accredited school to teach a firearms training course.

From the January general and board meetings:

Eagle Scout - The Eagle Scout rank is a life-long achievement that carries a special significance across all realms of life. The Eagle Scout Service project is what most people might think of when someone is working toward the rank of Eagle. The service project is the main step a Life Scout (rank) undertakes, requiring planning and developing and then leading a project that is beneficial to the community. There are many steps and standards that need to be met and approved before a service project begins.

Eagle Scout Emily was present to introduce Life Scout Kyliegh Dais and her Eagle Scout service project. Kylie explained that her project is dedicated to C.A.R.T. – Child Abuse Response Team – from the Tulare County District Attorney's office. Kyliegh said she is collecting stuffed animals that are given to children during a CART response team interview. The kids may be victims of child abuse or who have witnessed crimes. She went on to say that over 500 kids are interviewed each year in Tulare County and she is hoping to collect (at least) 555 plush toys. (Kyliegh said her favorite number is 5.)

Toys can be new or previously owned. They must be clean, in like new condition, not battery operated, and that they do not have any messages on them. In addition to scouring online retailers for purchases, she has also placed several drop boxes throughout town. There is a drop box at the VSA club house. A motion was made and approved at the meeting for a "pass the hat" fundraiser collection. Initially, the dollar amount was a bit shy of \$555.00. A couple members pitched in to bring the total to \$555.00.

4H Archery program - Hector Robles, program leader, said with the generous help of VSA club members and the 4H Tulare County office, a lot of bows and arrows are now available for the 16 kids in the start-up program. The VSA club has donated funds that will go towards targets, stands, and other supplies. Hector said a "neighbor" on the east side of town has agreed to provide access to some property for the team to shoot. Great!

[A quorum is the minimum number of members of an assembly or society that must be present at any of its meetings to make the proceedings of that meeting valid. For the VSA, it is the lesser of seventy-five (75) voting members or three and a half percent (3.5%) of the voting membership at any club meeting.]
