Range safety – Russ Beechinor related a range safety story about standing near an old flintlock rifle...you know the old firearms with the "flash in the pan" ignition. The flintlocks use a priming powder charge in the primer hole and the pan. Some flintlocks will need more priming powder than others. When the trigger is pulled, the flintlock strikes and the powder "flashes". Sometimes the powder in the pan is sent several feet in all directions. You don't want to be near that "flash in the pan!". You definitely need safety glasses any time you are around any of these old muzzle loaders. Small grains of powder can end up on your skin and clothing. Be aware.

**This just in:** July 24, 2025 (Reuters) - A divided federal appeals court on Thursday said California's first-of-its-kind law requiring firearm owners to undergo background checks to buy ammunition is unconstitutional, violating the Second Amendment right to bear arms.

In a 2-1 vote, the 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Pasadena, California, upheld a lower court judge's permanent injunction against enforcing the law.

CCW Classes at the club – There are TWO (2) classes scheduled for August. The first one is Saturday, August 2, 2025, 9 am to 5 pm. The second one is Friday, August 15, 8 am to 4 pm. After the class session at the VSA clubhouse, the afternoon instruction and qualifying shoot time will be at the range. (VSA Dale Wimp Rifle and Pistol Range, 7398 Ave 328, Visalia CA.) The state mandated instruction time for a <u>renewal</u> CCW is 8 hours. For a <u>new</u> CCW permit application, the requirement is 16 hours of instruction. You would need to attend two (2) of the 8-hour classes. There are two classes in **September**: Saturday, September 6, 9 am to 5 pm; and, Friday, September 19, 8 to 4pm.

CCW Class reservation: Class sizes will be limited to 40. If you want to attend the CCW class, <u>text</u> Albert Chan, 559-972-6537. Please provide your full name (as on your state issued ID) and your phone number. Please indicate if this is a renewal or new CCW application and if you are a current VSA member (or non-member). Due to the limited class size, you might not be scheduled for your first choice of class dates. There are now two (2) CCW instructors, Albert Chan and Wade Roberts, who coordinate together and schedule the classes. In addition, Scott James (CCW instructor) will fill in as needed. Payment info will be provided.

FEES:

VSA members: \$80.00 for 8-hour renewal \$200.00 for the 16-hour new CCW application Non-members: \$130.00 for 8-hour renewal \$250.00 for the 16-hour new CCW application **Additional info:** CCW class participants will need to draw from a holster (using dummy rounds/ snap caps, which will be provided). In addition, there are malfunction drills to perform.

**Reminder:** CCW Classes – As of July 1, 2025, if there are <u>no sign-ups</u> for a <u>CCW class</u>, the class will be canceled. The CCW instructors will NOT be at the club on the morning of a scheduled class if no one pre-registered for the class in advance. (This includes anyone needing the second 8-hour class for a renewal certificate.)

One of the most common questions I receive is "How do I pay for a membership renewal?" Here's my response: The best way to pay for a renewal membership is to go to the range on a "Public Shoot" day, or go to the clubhouse prior to a meeting. The club house meetings are the second Thursday of the month (August 14, September 11, etc) and someone is usually at the clubhouse on the meeting day from around 3 pm on. Check the range calendar schedule in the newsletter for the Public Shoot days.

Why the range or the club? They have the 2-part membership forms and can accept cash, checks, and credit/debit cards. Upon payment, you get the 2<sup>nd</sup> page of the membership form as your "proof of payment".

I will attach a renewal form to this email. If you use it to mail in a check to our post office box, please make a copy of your form as well as a copy or photo of your payment check. At this time, we do not recommend writing in any credit or debit card info on a mailed form.

I can mail you one of our renewal forms (the 2-part form) that you can fill out at home and take to the range, to the club, or mail in (you would mail in the top page and keep the second page) with your check payment. Let me know if you would like to have a form mailed to you.





