2025 ELECTION of Officers and Directors: The election is scheduled for the December 11, 2025, general club meeting. There are five (5) director positions that will be open at that time. CCW Class at the club – Starting with the classes in October, instructor Albert Chan has changed the Friday class time to 9 am to 5 pm. The Friday class now matches the Saturday class start time.

CCW Classes at the club – There are TWO (2) classes scheduled for October. The first one is Saturday, October 4, 2025, 9 am to 5 pm. The second one is Friday, October 10, 9 am to 5 pm. After the class session at the VSA clubhouse, the afternoon instruction and qualifying shoot time will be at the range. (VSA Dale Wimp Rifle and Pistol Range, 7398 Ave 328, Visalia CA.) The state mandated instruction time for a <u>renewal</u> CCW is 8 hours. For a <u>new</u> CCW permit application, the requirement is 16 hours of instruction. You would need to attend two (2) of the 8-hour classes. For **November**: Saturday, November 1st, and tentatively Friday, November 21st.

CCW Class reservation: Class sizes will be limited to 40. If you want to attend the CCW class, <u>text</u> Albert Chan, 559-972-6537. Please provide your full name (as on your state issued ID) and your phone number. Please indicate if this is a renewal or new CCW application and if you are a current VSA member (or non-member). Due to the limited class size, you might not be scheduled for your first choice of class dates. There are now two (2) CCW instructors, Albert Chan and Wade Roberts, who coordinate together and schedule the classes. In addition, Scott James (CCW instructor) will fill in as needed. Payment info will be provided.

Additional info: CCW class participants will need to draw from a holster (using dummy rounds/ snap caps, which will be provided). In addition, there are malfunction drills to perform.

Reminder: CCW Classes – As of July 1, 2025, if there are <u>no sign-ups</u> for a <u>CCW class</u>, the class will be canceled. The CCW instructors will NOT be at the club on the morning of a scheduled class if no one pre-registered for the class in advance. (This includes anyone needing the second 8-hour class for a renewal certificate.)





