Dirk Steelman announced that the VSA FFL services **have officially closed** as of the end of the year 2025.

The **.22 Rimfire Matches** at the VSA range are held on the second Sunday of every month, starting at 8 am. There is a \$10 registration fee. New this year are end-of-year prize awards. A .22 rifle will be awarded for the *highest year's total* score for each of the following: Men's scoped rifle class; Men's open sights rifle class; Junior's rifle class; and Women's rifle class. In addition, registered participating shooters will be given a ticket at each match. At the end of the year a winning ticket will be drawn. The Central California SCI chapter dinner that was scheduled for February 28th has been cancelled.

VSA board of directors unanimously approved the dissolution of the officer position of Executive Vice President now that the FFL services have been discontinued. It was announced in December that Dirk Steelman found the benefit to club members was far outweighed by the laws and regulations placed on a home-based FFL (especially) with few sales. The FFL license for the club was originally started by Doug Steelman in 1974.

In other discussion at the board meeting: It was decided to get new floor mats and a vacuum to maintain them for the clubhouse. Kelly S., treasurer, received guidance on who is to have a credit card issued to them and their credit limits. There is the need to have food purchases for the dinners, maintenance and repairs for the club, supplies and repairs and the range, technology for the club and range, etc., with several people “in charge” of those items and the responsibility that goes with having a company credit card. Kelly S. stated she has received conflicting information from BMO bank personnel on the procedures for the club to close the bank account and related credit cards account. Hopefully something can be done in the near future to be done with BMO. As directed by the board members, Kelly is working on preparing a monthly accounting statement of income and expenses. In regards to the ongoing process of moving the VSA corporate structure from a 501c7 “Member Benefit” organization to a 501c3 “Charitable” organization, Russ said the attorney needs updated financials, tax returns, and possibly revisions to the revised bylaws. Getting closer? We hope so.

CW Classes – Albert Chan, CCW class instructor at the club has announced that the scheduled second CCW class of each month has been cancelled due to a lack of interest. Effective February 1st. There will be only one regularly scheduled CCW class per month, usually scheduled the first Saturday each month.

CCW Classes at the club – As of February 2026, there is only one class scheduled per month. The class for February will be **Saturday, February 7, 9 am to 5 pm**. After the class session at the VSA clubhouse, the afternoon instruction and qualifying shoot time will be at the range. (VSA Dale Wimp Rifle and Pistol Range, 7398 Ave 328, Visalia CA.) The state mandated instruction time for a renewal CCW is 8 hours. For a new CCW permit application, the requirement is 16 hours of instruction. You would need to attend two (2) of the 8-hour classes.

CCW Class reservation: Class sizes will be limited to 40. If you want to attend the CCW class, text Albert Chan, 559-972-6537. Please provide your full name (as on your state issued ID) and your phone number. Please indicate if this is a renewal or new CCW application and if you are a current VSA member (or non-member). Due to the limited class size, you might not be scheduled for your first choice of class dates. In addition, Scott James (CCW instructor) will fill in as needed. Payment info will be provided.

FEES:

VSA members: \$80.00 for 8-hour renewal \$200.00 for the 16-hour new CCW application

Non-members: \$130.00 for 8-hour renewal \$250.00 for the 16-hour new CCW application

Additional info: CCW class participants will need to draw from a holster (using dummy rounds/ snap caps, which will be provided). In addition, there are malfunction drills to perform.

Reminder: CCW Classes – As of July 1, 2025, if there are no sign-ups for a CCW class, the class will be canceled. The CCW instructors will NOT be at the club on the morning of a scheduled class if no one pre-registered for the class in advance. (This includes anyone needing the second 8-hour class for a renewal certificate.)
